ACCESSING PARTICIPATION FORMS

- To access the required athletic participation forms, place your cursor over the “Electronic Participation Forms” tab to view the drop down menu.
- Click on the form name and fill out the information requested. If you are unsure about the answer to a question, please answer N/A, unknown or none.
- To sign the document, click inside the signature box and hold your mouse button down, this will allow you to create an “Electronic Signature.” If you make a mistake and need to start over, click on the refresh icon next to the signature box.
- Once you have completed each form, you will have the opportunity to print the document.
- **You will receive a confirmation email once the documents have been reviewed by the Northside ISD Athletic Trainers.**
- Once completed, click on the “Medical History/Physical” tab to fill out and print the physical page to take with you to the doctor if you haven’t already done so.
- Athletes in 7th, 9th and 11th grade ***must*** have an annual physical examination by a medical doctor to participate in practices or games.

You MUST have your **student’s ID number** available as it is required on each form!

DO NOT USE ATHLETE NICKNAMES ON FORMS

- All Middle and High School athletes must fill out each form on Rank One, regardless of grade level.
- Please make sure all information is accurate, as this will be used in case of emergency.
- Parent/Guardian AND Student signatures are required in order for forms to be accepted electronically.

NOTE FOR PHYSICALS:

1. Students are required to use the Pre-participation Physical Examination Form provided by the UIL. **NO OTHER** Physical Examination Form can be accepted.
2. Physicals must be dated, from a physician, **after April 1, 2017** to be accepted for the 2017-2018 school year.
3. This form can be accessed from the Medical History/Physical tab.

Physicals and Medical History forms are not submitted online. They must be completed by a Physician and returned to either the Campus Athletic Trainers (for high school students/those entering grades 9-12th) or the Middle School head coaches (for students entering 6-8th). **No one else can accept this form.**
